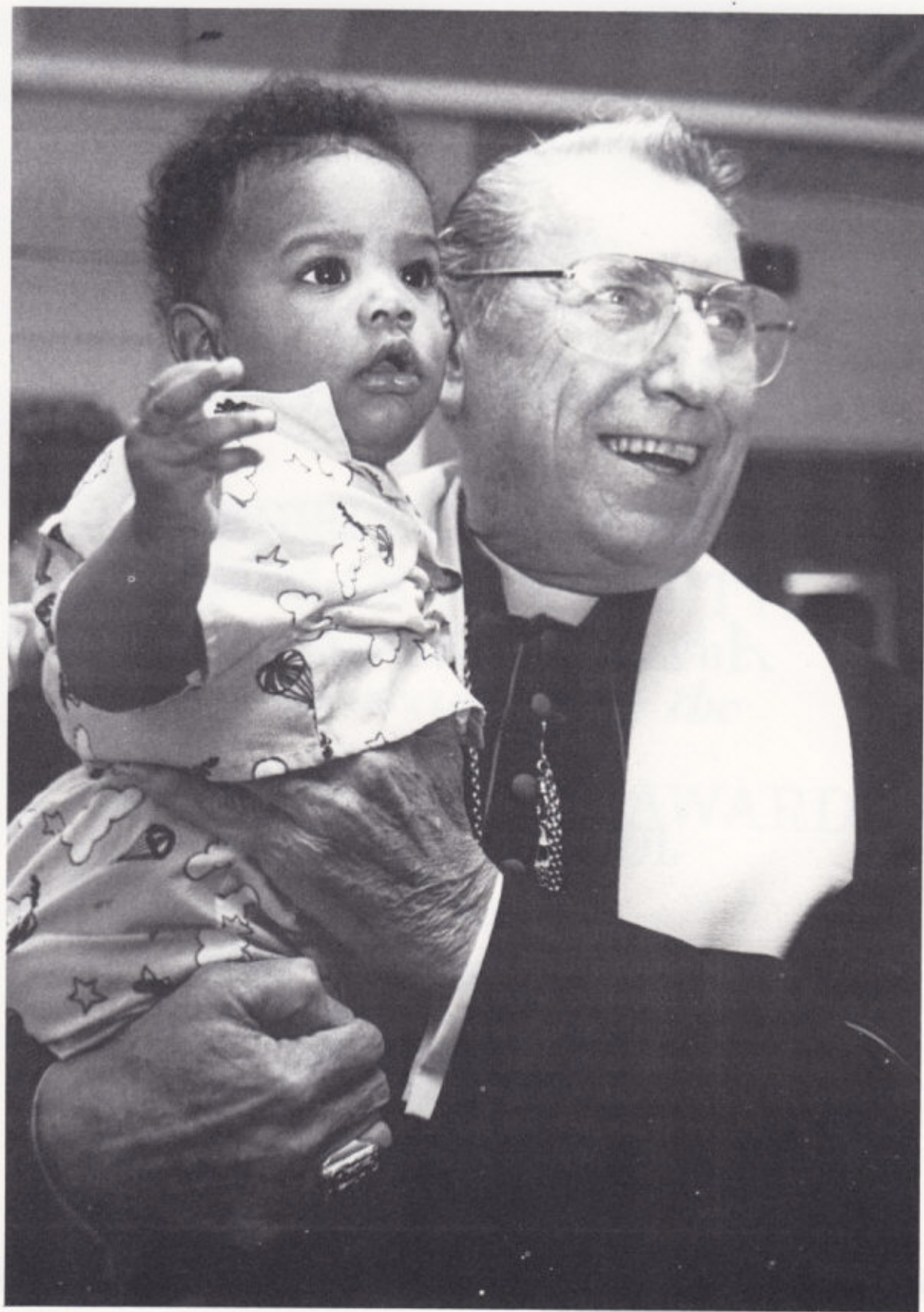
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His Eminence, John Cardinal O'Connor

The Cardinal's Committee of the Laity (CCL) is a group of prominent individuals dedicated to responding to those most in need throughout the ten counties of the Archdiocese of New York, regardless of race, color or religion. Through giving of its time and resources, this dynamic group has taken an active role in lessening the burdens of poverty, disease, and ignorance. Since its inception in 1933, the CCL has raised over \$82 million.

Under the leadership of His Eminence, John Cardinal O'Connor, the CCL has raised millions of dollars in support of the charitable and educational efforts of the Archdiocese. It assists Catholic Charities in its outreach to more than 200 affiliated agencies and provides support to the Archdiocesan Department of Education and its over 290 schools.

Through the efforts of the CCL, the Archdiocese of New York is able to touch the lives of almost one million men, women, and children annually through social services such as mental health clinics, family counseling, programs for the homeless and hungry, care for persons with AIDS from infants to adults, help for the elderly, hospitals, nursing homes and child care facilities.

In supporting the Archdiocesan educational system, the CCL provides assistance in educating more than 107,000 students each year, of whom approximately 47,000 are in the scarred inner-city. These schools provide a value-centered education while giving each student the necessary tools and guidance to make a significant contribution to society as they achieve their own potential.

The Hospitality and Tourism Division has supported the efforts of the Cardinal's Committee of the Laity in a special way, raising over \$1.2 million through 8 previous award dinners. On this occasion, the Cardinal's Committee is proud to honor with its 1995 Award John G. Flynn and Thomas W. Monetti for their many years of dedicated service to the Hospitality and Tourism industry.

John Flynn was appointed General Manager of The Sky Club, considered one of the premier private business clubs in the United States, in October 1992.

A native New Yorker he distinguished himself in the Hospitality Industry starting in 1971 as a Banquet Manager of the New York Hilton Hotel and ultimately as Director of Catering of The Waldorf=Astoria. In 1980 he was honored by the Hilton Corporation as outstanding Catering Director of the Year.

After a ten year association with Hilton Hotels, he assumed the catering responsibilities of the Helmsley Palace Hotel, the Harvard Club of New York City and the Grand Hyatt Hotel until accepting the General Manager position at the Board Room Club in May of 1988.

He acquired a strong hospitality background with majors in marketing at Manhattan College, and Hotel and Restaurant Management at the State University of New York. He concluded his studies in the Continuing Education Program at Cornell University majoring in finance. Currently John serves on the Board of the Culinary Institute of America as a Member of the Corporation.

His many charitable and philanthropic affiliations include the Sovereign Military Order-Knights of Malta, Board Member of the Archdiocese of New York Drug Abuse Prevention Program, Cardinal's Committee of the Laity – serving two years as Dinner Chairman – The Friendly Sons of Saint Patrick, The Waldorf=Astoria Distinguished Alumni, Co-Chair of the American Jewish Committee Hospitality Division Co-Chair of the Boy Scouts of America Hotel and Restaurant Division and the Club Managers Association of America.

John resides with his wife, Christine, and son, Matthew, in Rye, New York.

The Cardinal's Committee of the Laity is proud to pay tribute to Thomas W. Monetti, Managing Director of Tavern on the Green, for his outstanding professional achievements and impressive record of community service.

A native of Sandy Hook, Connecticut, Thomas Monetti is a graduate of the University of Connecticut, with a degree in business administration. After gaining valuable experience in the hotel and restaurant business, he joined the Hilton Hotels Corporation in New York, culminating a ten year stint as Director of Food and Beverage at the Waldorf=Astoria. While at the Waldorf, he spearheaded the restoration of all the hotel's food and beverage facilities and helped restore much of the hotel's art deco elegance. Prior to his current position, he served as the manager of New York's renowned Ritz-Carlton Hotel, where he oversaw the rehabilitation of the hotel's 231 guest rooms and suites, as well as its Jockey Club Restaurant. Since his joining Tavern in 1988, the restaurant has continued to enjoy great success, as evidenced by its unprecedented \$30 million in sales in 1994.

Despite the great demands of his profession, our honoree has also been devoted to a number of worthy causes. Tom was recently honored by the American Jewish Committee Hotel and Hospitality Division at their Annual Achievement Dinner. He has enjoyed a 15-year affiliation with the Cardinal's Committee of the Laity, and was chiefly responsible for its first Hospitality and Tourism Awards dinner, which raised over a half million dollars. He is a member of the American Association of the Sovereign Military Order of Malta and the Association of Knights and Ladies of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulcher of Jerusalem. In addition, he has been actively involved with the Greater New York Boy Scouts of America, the Harlem AIDS Ministry, and the Barbara Sinatra Children's Hospital, where he served as Co-Chair for a gala benefit dinner honoring the late Jilly Rizzo.

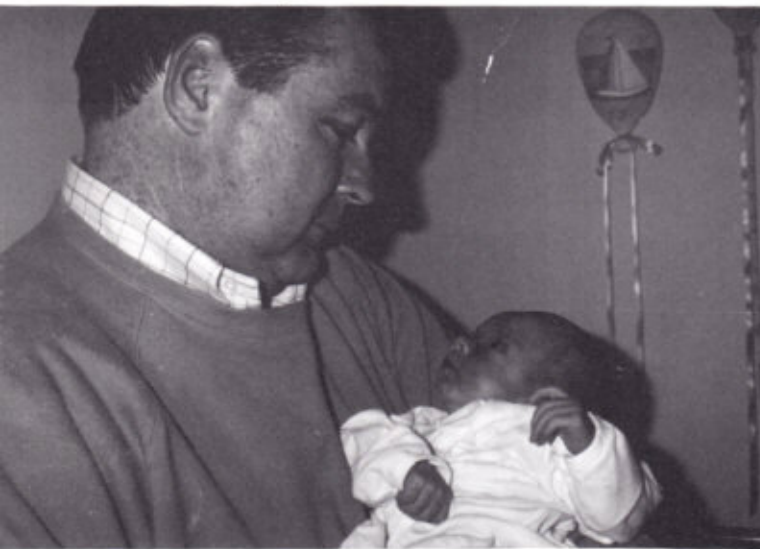

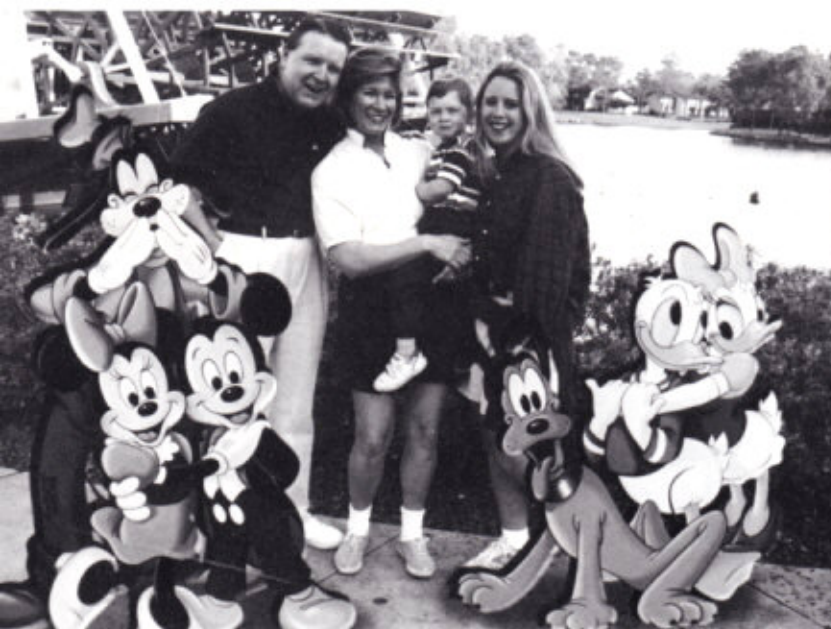

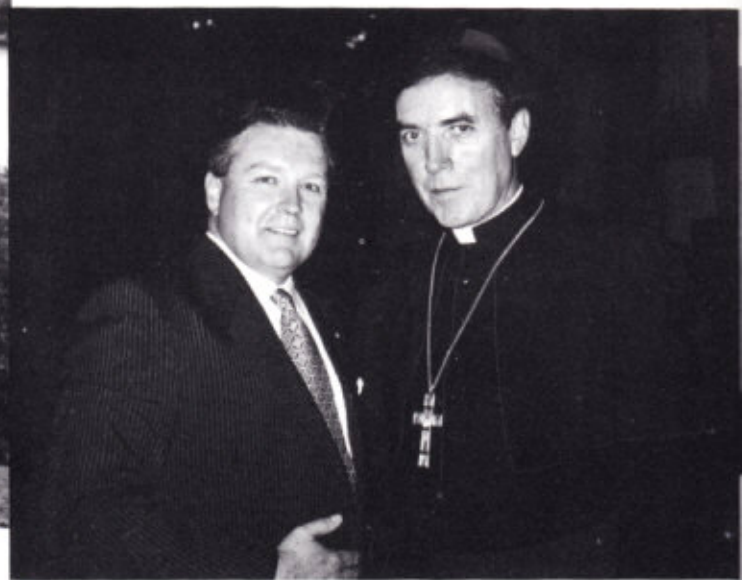
